

**AGREEMENT WITH INDIVIDUAL VOLUNTEER
EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT**

The undersigned is a Volunteer Employee of the EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT effective- October 28, 2006 through October 29, 2006 according to the Personnel Administrative Manual, Chapter III, Sec. C, No. 6, which reads:

"A volunteer employee is a person in an employee status pursuant to written agreement specifying uncompensated status. A volunteer will be deemed an employee for the District for the purposes of Division 4 of the Labor Code, for any injury sustained while engaged in the performance of any service under the direction and control of the Park District."

The Volunteer Employee will be doing work as described below:

LOCATION- Miller/Knox Regional Shoreline, Richmond

WORK- Assisting with invasive plant removal on varied terrain, planting native plants, and removing shoreline debris.

The potential hazards of this work are:

Dirty and wet clothing, walking on uneven ground, bending, crouching, and working for 30 minute intervals.

The recommended personal protective equipment includes:

Wear clothes that can get wet and soiled. Closed-toed, sturdy shoes are essential. Gloves and bags will be provided.

I understand the potential hazards of this work as they have been explained to me and am unaware of any existing medical conditions which may be adversely affected by this work.
