How to Prepare:

- 1) **Closed-toe shoes are required.** Also, dress in layers, bring a hat, and wear clothing that can get dirty and will be comfortable for working outdoors. Long pants and long sleeves are recommended.
- 2) Bring the **required waiver forms** to the event, signed by your parent/guardian if you are under the age of 18.
- 3) Please bring your own water bottle to help us cut down on plastic!

Gloves, tools, snacks, and water are provided.

Bus Transportation:

Bus service reservations are first-come, first-served for groups that have a minimum of 15 students signed up to attend this event. An adult chaperone must accompany each group of students on the bus unless you get consent from EarthTeam to send a group without a chaperone. We request a \$3 donation per person to help offset the high cost of bus rental. However, no one will be denied the right to use the bus service due to a lack of funds.

Driving Directions:

Strentzel Meadow is located at 5026 Alhambra Valley Rd., Martinez. Meadow Access is off a private driveway and parking is limited. Coming from Hwy 4, take the Alhambra Valley off ramp. Head South on Alhambra Ave. Continue on Alhambra Ave. for about ½ mile to next traffic light. Turn Right on Alhambra Valley Rd. Go past John Swett Elementary on your left. About ¼ mile (or a little less) beyond the school, look for a gravel driveway on your right, pull in and park on the gravel space (do not block the driveway). You are at Strentzel Meadow and should see the EarthTeam banner and staff! If the parking area is full you can park at John Swett Elementary and walk over to the meadow.

In Case of Rain:

Be prepared to work in heavy fog or light rain. If there is heavy rain, however, the restoration program will be cancelled. To confirm, please call 510-725-5658 after 8:00 am, the morning of the event.
